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A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE HORTON

The Barnabas Horton family traveled by ship from England to the United States in the 17th century. Their journey over generations eventually brought them to Cook's Gap, near the Blue Ridge Parkway. They were impressed by the natural landscape and chose to settle in the area, being some of the very first to call Watauga County home. In the 1920's, H.W. Horton transformed what was a Studebaker car dealership on King Street into a storefront for Spainhour's Department Store. Over the decades, a number of business have taken over the space and in February of 2018, locals, Fulton & Denise Lovin, revitalized the Horton name and designed a space that honors the traditions of our small town while providing a unique boutique experience.
